Did you mainly attend a state or fee paying school between the ages 11 – 18?

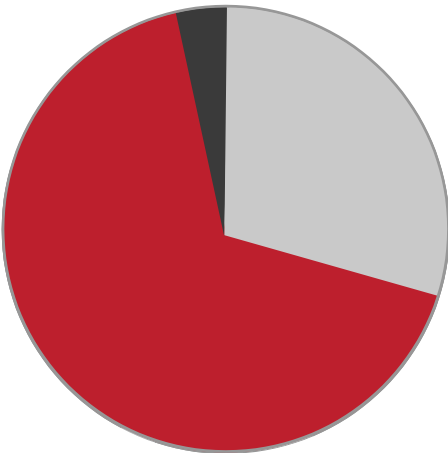

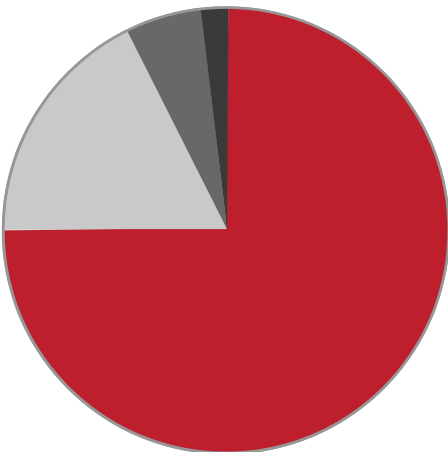
